1st Scripture Reading: Psalm 139:1-6; 13-18 (NKJV)

139 O Lord, You have searched me and known *me*. ² You know my sitting down and my rising up; You understand my thought afar off. You ^[a] comprehend my path and my lying down, and are acquainted with all my ways. ⁴ For *there is* not a word on my tongue, *but* behold, O Lord, You know it altogether. ⁵ You have ^[b]hedged me behind and before, and laid Your hand upon me. ⁶ *Such* knowledge *is* too wonderful for me; It is high, I cannot *attain* it.

¹³ For You formed my inward parts; You ^[a]covered me in my mother's womb.

¹⁴ I will praise You, for ^[b]I am fearfully *and* wonderfully made; Marvelous are Your works, and *that* my soul knows very well. ¹⁵ My ^[c]frame was not hidden from You, when I was made in secret, *and* skillfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. ¹⁶ Your eyes saw my substance, being yet unformed.

And in Your book they all were written, the days fashioned for me, When *as yet there were* none of them. ¹⁷ How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them! ¹⁸ If I should count them, they would be more in number than the sand;

When I awake, I am still with You.

2nd Scripture Reading: Jeremiah 18:1-6 (NKJV)

18 The word which came to Jeremiah from the Lord, saying: ² "Arise and go down to the potter's house, and there I will cause you to hear My words." ³ Then I went down to the potter's house, and there he was, making something at the ^[a]wheel. ⁴ And the vessel that he ^[b]made of clay was ^[c]marred in the hand of the potter; so he made it again into another vessel, as it seemed good to the potter to make.

⁵ Then the word of the Lord came to me, saying: ⁶ "O house of Israel, can I not do with you as this potter?" says the Lord. "Look, as the clay *is* in the potter's hand, so *are* you in My hand, O house of Israel!
