
## 1<sup>st</sup> Scripture Reading: Zephaniah 3:14-20 (NKJV)

<sup>14</sup> Sing, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O Israel! Be glad and rejoice with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem! <sup>15</sup> The LORD has taken away your judgments, He has cast out your enemy. The King of Israel, the LORD, *is* in your midst; you shall <sup>[a]</sup>see disaster no more. <sup>16</sup> In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem: "Do not fear; Zion, let not your hands be weak. <sup>17</sup> The LORD your God in your midst, the Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet *you* with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing." <sup>18</sup> "I will gather those who sorrow over the appointed assembly, who are among you, *to whom* its reproach *is* a burden. <sup>19</sup> Behold, at that time I will deal with all who afflict you; I will save the lame, and gather those who were driven out; I will appoint them for praise and fame in every land where they were put to shame. <sup>20</sup> At that time I will bring you back, even at the time I gather you; for I will give you <sup>[b]</sup>fame and praise among all the peoples of the earth, when I return your captives before your eyes," says the LORD.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Scripture Reading: Isaiah 61:1-4, 8-11 (NKJV)

"The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon Me, because the LORD has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to <sup>[a]</sup>heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *those who are* bound; <sup>2</sup> to proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn, <sup>3</sup> to <sup>[b]</sup>console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified." <sup>4</sup> And they shall rebuild the old ruins, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the ruined cities, the desolations of many generations.

<sup>8</sup> "For I, the LORD, love justice; I hate robbery <sup>[a]</sup>for burnt offering; I will direct their work in truth, and will make with them an everlasting covenant. <sup>9</sup> Their descendants shall be known among the Gentiles, and their offspring among the people. All who see them shall acknowledge them, that they *are* the posterity *whom* the LORD has blessed." <sup>10</sup> I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks *himself* with ornaments, and as a bride adorns *herself* with her jewels. <sup>11</sup> For as the earth brings forth its bud, as the garden causes the things that are sown in it to spring forth, so the Lord GOD will cause righteousness and praise to spring forth before all the nations.
