There may be some ideas that most people agree need immediate attention.*

The following is a list of ideas brainstormed by John to get the ball rolling:

1. Increase participation at Sunday Worship. HOW?
2. Weekly Prayer service. **(Already going at 9:30 am Sundays. Join Us!)**
3. Obtain Landmark Status.

5. Begin Sunday School for children.
