The Apostle Paul in Romans 8:35 asked himself: Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Nothing can stop us; nothing can take away the joy and desire to worship Jesus Christ. In this time of waiting, I advise you to take time to rest, meditate and draw closer to God through your prayers, searching the Word, and fasting.
